

RESOLUTION 1615

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BEND, WASHINGTON, AUTHORIZING THE SUBMITTAL OF A FEDERAL LANDS ACCESS PROGRAM GRANT APPLICATION

WHEREAS, the City of North Bend desires to make improvements to 468th Avenue SE, SE 140th Street, Middle Fork Road and the intersection of 468th Avenue SE and SE 140th Street/Middle Fork Road; and

WHEREAS, the October 2012 update of the Transportation Element of the Comprehensive Plan recommends improvements to the City's Transportation Infrastructure for the previously indicated area; and

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Transportation, Federal Highway Administration, Western Federal Lands Division, Washington State Federal Lands Access Program (FLAP) is soliciting Request for Proposals; and

WHEREAS, the City in conjunction with the USDA Department of Agriculture-Mt. Baker-Snoqualmie National Forest, wish to submit a Project Proposal to the Washington State Federal Lands Application Program; and

WHEREAS, if the application is approved and subsequent grant contract executed, Federal funds of up to 86.5 % of the available costs of the project would be made available to the City;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH BEND, WASHINGTON, DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Mayor and/or his designee are authorized to submit a joint Project Proposal Application to the Washington State Federal Lands Application Program, in a form as approved by the City Attorney.
