

ORDINANCE 1505

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF NORTH BEND, WASHINGTON, AMENDING CHAPTERS 2.07 AND 2.09 TO THE NORTH BEND MUNICIPAL CODE CREATING THE POSITION OF FINANCE DIRECTOR AND ELIMINATING THE POSITIONS OF ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES DIRECTOR AND FINANCE MANAGER; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, in order to meet operational and staffing changes in 2011, the City reorganized the Administration and Finance Departments subsequently creating the positions of the Administrative Services Director and Finance Manager and eliminating the position of Finance Director; and

WHEREAS, due to a proposed reorganization of the Administration and Finance Department, the City wishes to now eliminate the positions of Administrative Services Director and Finance Manager and reestablish the position of Finance Director;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH BEND, WASHINGTON, DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. NBMC Chapter 2.07, entitled “Administrative Services Director” Repealed. Chapter 2.07 of the North Bend Municipal Code is hereby repealed in its entirety.

Section 2. NBMC Chapter 2.09, entitled “Finance Manager” Amended. Chapter 2.09 of the North Bend Municipal Code is hereby amended as follows:

Chapter 2.09 FINANCE DIRECTOR

Sections:

- 2.09.010 Office established.
- 2.09.020 Auditing officer.
- 2.09.030 References amended.

2.09.010 Office established.

There is established the position known as the finance director or finance director/assistant city administrator, to be filled by the appointment of the mayor.

2.09.020 Auditing officer.

The finance director is hereby designated as the auditing officer for the city of North Bend as required by Chapter 42.24 RCW.

2.09.030 References amended.

All references in the North Bend Municipal Code to “finance manager” shall hereafter be amended to read “finance director.”

Section 3. Severability. Should any section, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance, or its application to any person or circumstance, be declared unconstitutional or otherwise invalid for any reason, or should any portion of this ordinance be pre-empted by state or federal law or regulation, such decision or pre-emption shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance or its application to other persons or circumstances.

Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall be published in the official newspaper of the City, and shall take effect and be in full force five (5) days after the date of publication.
