

NORTH BEND CITY COUNCIL MINUTES

August 5, 2014

Senior Center, 411 Main Ave. S., North Bend, Washington

CALL TO ORDER, ROLL CALL:

Mayor Hearing called the regular meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

Councilmembers Present: Cook, Gothelf, Kolodejchuk, Loudenback, Pettersen and Williamson. Councilmember Rosen was excused.

Mayor Hearing recessed the meeting at 7:01 p.m. for a special meeting of the North Bend Transportation Benefit District Board.

Mayor Hearing called the meeting back to order at 7:04 p.m.

Councilmember Pettersen **MOVED**, seconded by Councilmember Gothelf to move AB14-086 – Ordinance Amending 2014 Budget Ordinance 1513 from the main agenda to the consent agenda. The motion **PASSED** 6-0.

Councilmember Loudenback **MOVED**, seconded by Councilmember Williamson to approve the consent agenda as amended. The motion **PASSED** 6-0.

CITIZEN'S COMMENTS:

Travis Bridgman, 713 Ogle Ave NE, encouraged all to enjoy the upcoming Festival at Mt Si and acknowledged those volunteers that help with community events like the Festival.

Terry Tatko, 13124 455th Place SE, thanked Council for their consideration of comments received regarding the rate and type of growth occurring in the City and their recent action at the July 1st Council meeting that supported a more rural growth environment. She encouraged the City to work with the developers that had already submitted applications in order to minimize the density and impact of their proposed developments.

Ken Workman, 13105 455th Place SE, noted he had reviewed plans for the proposed Segale development on Tanner Road and expressed concern about the lack of change to the existing road structure considering the increase in traffic the development would create.

ANNOUNCEMENTS, PRESENTATIONS, APPOINTMENTS:

AB14-084 – Appointments of CERT Coordinator

Mayor Hearing recommended the appointment of Patrick Davis as the City of North Bend Community Emergency Response Team (CERT) Emergency Management Coordinator.

Councilmember Williamson **MOVED**, seconded by Councilmember Kolodejchuk to approve AB14-084, appointing Patrick Davis as the North Bend CERT Emergency Management Coordinator. The motion **PASSED** 6-0.

Public Works Director Rigos provided the staff report.

Councilmember Loudenback **MOVED**, seconded by Councilmember Williamson to approve AB14-085, authorizing a contract with Perteet, Inc. to perform survey and traffic analysis work for the Downtown Plaza Project. The motion **PASSED** 5-1 (Kolodejchuk).

MAYOR, COUNCIL, AND ADMINISTRATOR CONCERNS AND INITIATIVES:

Councilmembers encouraged everyone to attend the Festival at Mt Si and thanked all the volunteers that worked so hard to make the event such a success.

Councilmember Williamson reminded everyone be aware of the dangers of skin cancer particularly during the summer months. He thanked Patrick Davis for volunteering to serve as North Bend's CERT Emergency Management Coordinator.

City Administrator Lindell provided an update on the abatement work on the property located adjacent to City Hall. She noted that the City would be working with the Snoqualmie Valley Gardening Club to help beautify the area after the clearing was completed. Additionally, she announced Piccola Winery, which was the tenant of the old fire station, would be having a soft opening during the weekend of the Festival at Mt Si.
