AGENDA ITEM #2: Approval of 4/24/2014 and 5/8/2014 Minutes

The April 24, 2014 and May 8, 2014 Minutes from the previous meetings were approved.

AGENDA ITEM #3: Public Comment on Non Agenda Items (Limited to 3 Minutes per Person)

AGENDA ITEM #4: Comprehensive Plan Land Use Element – Continued Deliberation

After discussion of Agenda Item #5, the Commissioners and city staff discussed the Comprehensive Plan Land Use Element. Chair McFarland asked if any guest would like to speak to this item. No one spoke.

There was discussion, including questions and answers, between the Commissioners and city staff concerning this Agenda Item.

Chair McFarland provided the comments and questions below in an email on 5.15.2014, which encapsulates his comments and questions he had concerning this topic. Chair McFarland asked that these comments be added to the minutes.

- Do the areas/acreage of land by zone (table D.2.A) support the cities growth and vision for employment and mix of housing stock?
- How do these percentages by use (perhaps by group residential/commercial) compare to model planning and/or communities of similar size and future growth to us?
- Do our current set of zones (i.e. DC, MU, etc.) still accurately reflect the intent and use when originally created?
- Should any zone(s) be eliminated/revised/added?
- What zones overlay still make sense and/or could be better incorporated? Conversely, are there any potential overlays that would serve us better?
- How do we both write this to "bring us up to date" with changes and better position the text to allow for normal changes through time?
- What is a brief history of zoning changes incorporated since early '90s (e.g. how/when did we get to LDR = 4DU)?
- What is the purpose of our historic district destinations and how are they helping/hurting business growth?
