REUSABLE HOUSEHOLD GOODS	Small appliances in working condition, reusable clothing, shoes, pots, pans, bedding, books, toys.	No broken, torn, stained, wet items. No furniture, carpet or mattresses.	
BATTERIES	Car, truck, marine lead acid batteries. Household alkaline, rechargeable & button		Pre-sort large quantities.
TIRES	On or off rim light truck, car and motorcycle tires. Bias ply, steel-belted & studded tires accepted.	No Commercial Vehicle Tires.	This is a residential event.
PETROLEUM PRODUCTS	Motor oil, gasoline, diesel fuel, 2-cycle mix, transmission & brake fluid, kerosene, antifreeze and oil filters.	No unmarked or mixed liquids.	Do not mix liquids together.
ELECTRONICS	Computer CPU's, monitors, keyboards, mice Scanners / fax machine, cell phones, VCR's Printers, copier/laptop, CD/DVD players, Televisions, Stereos.	No commercial equipment This is a residential event. No large copiers.	E-Cycle Washington Is a program that provides Free recycling of computers, Monitors, laptops & TV's. 1-800-RECYCLE *Year Round
FLUORESCENT BULBS/TUBES	Fluorescent Bulbs or Tubes.	No lighting fixtures or broken tubes.	Double bag & take to Waste mobile (see below)
YARD WASTE	Grass, Leaves, Weeds, Branches up to 3" Diameter & 3 feet long.	Large branches, Sod or Dirt, Rocks, Wood Stumps, Manure, Plastic Bags.	No Trash or Construction Debris
REFRIGERATORS, FREEZERS, AIR CONDITIONERS	Household refrigerators, Household freezers and air conditioners.	No commercial appliances or automobile air conditioning units.	
SCRAP METAL & APPLIANCES	Barbecues, microwaves, cast iron sinks and tubs, lawnmowers (remove gas & oil) Stove, hot water heaters, washer & dryers, dishwashers, other.	No cars, trailers, or greasy metal. No propane tanks.	Please drain all liquids remove plastic or rubber from metal.

PLEASE DO NOT BRING: Any-oil-based paint, pesticides, or household chemicals-take to Household Hazardous Waste mobile which is at the Duvall Safeway at 14020 Main St NE on 10/18-10/20 No packing peanuts or planter pots. Latex Paint is no longer accepted- please dry out and place in trash.
